From the Vice-Dean's Corner:

As you know, spaces for research on campus are severely limited. Making the situation more challenging is the fact our campus lab spaces are scattered across at least three locations, at Lees, Montpetit and Roger Guindon. It is essential that we try to better understand how we are using these spaces so that we can respond effectively when needs arise. A process began over a year ago to investigate opportunities for sharing research spaces in situations where it would be sensible to do so. They include spaces where researchers are undertaking similar activities, often using the same kinds of equipment, which could become platforms for research. Advantages for sharing spaces include minimizing costly duplication of expensive equipment and related building renovations and technical support, promoting interdisciplinary collaborations, enhancing student training opportunities, and better planning for expansions that include recruiting new faculty members. At the same time, there may be important unique facilities that may not lend themselves well to this model. You may have already contributed to discussions that led to proposals for how shared research platforms may be conceived and managed. We are in a process now of working with lab user groups across campus to examine how best to move forward in this direction. Some of you have been part of a shared lab culture for some time, and we want to create fora for learning from each other and sharing best practices. In the upcoming months, there will be a number of opportunities for you to participate. In the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.
